


Your manual will come in 317 pages and you will want to have it printed out with a professional printer due to the amount of ink involved. You Might try a Kinkos, OfficeMax, or another sort of printer to print it with a laser copier.

All you need to do is save your manual to a flash drive and present it to the printing company. They will be able to print it off from there. Some companies will also allow you to email it beforehand. Either way, you need to have it in a binder during this entire process. The cost is usually around 20 dollars.



Printing it with an inkjet system will cost more. It's cheaper to let a printing company print your manual if you do not own a laser printer.

Make notes in your manual as you move along the audio and be able to reference when needed. We do not want you to learn from just reading off the computer screen. Hard print of your manual and other materials will only help you develop learning habits. After all, the knowledge is priceless. Next, get you a binder the same as the one in the picture. You have a lot of additional documents that we want you to print out.



Print all the necessary outlines that come with a recording so that you can

build your manual library. Follow the outline you have printed with the recording so you can make the necessary notes. This allows you to return and go over any information you feel is important or just to review notes. Print any training information that you feel will help you with any subject and add it to your binder. Your binder will begin to grow in depth as you make your way through the learning stages.
